Indiana State University STUDENT COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER APPLICANT GUIDELINES Winter 2023

General Guidelines:

A commencement speech is an address given to graduating students. Your speech should have a coherent message. You may want to consider the following questions to get you started:

- How does earning a college degree enable you to contribute to the world?
- What role does passion and commitment play in academic success?
- What is the enduring value of a collegiate degree?
- In what ways does ISU help to broaden students' horizons?

Requirements:

- Speeches should be as close to **five minutes** as possible, but no longer.
- **GPA of 2.75** or higher is preferred.
- Speeches should be submitted and retained electronically.
- Applicants must be a **Senior (undergraduate) graduating in December** 2023 and participating in the Winter 2023 Commencement program.

Applicants will need to submit:

- ✓ A final draft of your speech
- ✓ Completed Permission to Check and Publicize GPA form

Speech Submission Deadline is 12:00pm, Monday, October 2, 2023

- The Student Commencement Speaker Selection Committee will review all submitted speeches. All applicants will be contacted by <u>Monday, October, 9th</u>, with the committee's decision as to whether or not they were selected to audition.
- Students with selected speeches will be provided a time to audition/present before the selection committee on <u>Thursday, October 19th, between 4:00-6:00pm</u>. The presentation will take approximately 15 minutes.
- Please hold October 19, from 4-6pm, as that will be the only opportunity to present.
