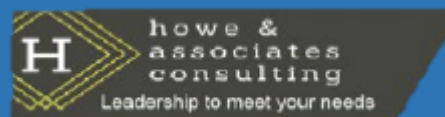

SUZANNE ECKES**



Suzanne Eckes, J.D., Ph.D is a professor in the Educational Leadership and Policy Studies Department at Indiana University. Dr. Eckes has published several education law-related articles and book chapters. She is a co-author or co-editor of several books, including *Legal Rights of School Leaders, Teachers, and Students* and *Legal Rights of Teachers and Students*. Much of her research focuses on how civil rights laws influence education policy for historically marginalized populations in public schools. She is a past president of the Education Law Association and a monthly legal contributor to the National Association of Secondary School Principals' *Principal Leadership* magazine. Prior to joining the faculty at Indiana University, Dr. Eckes was a public high school French teacher and an attorney. She continues to work as an expert witness in education-related litigation.
