Before priority registration begins, take 5 minutes and complete the **Take 5 checklist** to ensure you can enroll in courses and receive your financial aid on time:

- 1. Check your university email regularly.**
Don't miss important notifications from the Financial Aid office.
- 2. Resolve all holds on your account and financial aid issues** under student alerts in red text in the MyISU portal.
- 3. Add or update your proxy access** in the MyISU portal.
- 4. Make arrangements** to cover expenses and avoid late fees. Students with unpaid charges may not be able to register.
- 5. File your 2022-2023 FAFSA** at fafsa.gov using your 2020 federal tax information. April 15th deadline for Indiana Residents.

Please complete all items before the semester ends. Late submissions are not guaranteed to be processed prior to the start of the next semester classes.
