APPLICANT GUIDELINES
Winter 2023

General Guidelines:

A commencement speech is an address given to graduating students. Your speech should have a coherent message.

You may want to consider the following questions to get you started:

- How does earning a college degree enable you to contribute to the world?
- What role does passion and commitment play in academic success?
- What is the enduring value of a collegiate degree?
- In what ways does ISU help to broaden students' horizons?

Requirements:

- Speeches should be as close to **five minutes** as possible, but no longer.
- **GPA of 2.75** or higher is preferred.
- Speeches should be submitted and retained electronically.
- Applicants must be a **Senior (undergraduate) graduating in December 2023 and participating in the Winter 2023 Commencement program.**

Applicants will need to submit:

- ✓ A final draft of your speech
- ✓ Completed Permission to Check and Publicize GPA form

Speech Submission Deadline is 12:00pm, Monday, October 2, 2023

- The Student Commencement Speaker Selection Committee will review all submitted speeches. All applicants will be contacted by Monday, October, 9th, with the committee's decision as to whether or not they were selected to audition.
- Students with selected speeches will be provided a time to audition/present before the selection committee on Thursday, October 19th, between 4:00-6:00pm. The presentation will take approximately 15 minutes.
- *Please hold October 19, from 4-6pm, as that will be the only opportunity to present.*
